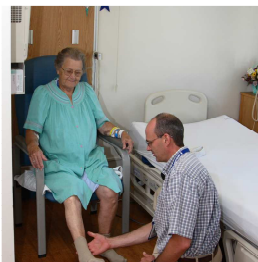
If you or a family member are on your way to recovery, but need a little extra care right now, the Skilled Care Program at LRHC may be just what the doctor ordered.

Who Needs Rehabilitative Care/Skilled care Services

- ◆ Patients needing rehabilitative physical therapy services following an orthopedic surgery
- ◆ Patients needing IV therapy
- ◆ Patients needing care of wounds which require daily evaluation and treatment by skilled personnel
- ◆ Patients with stroke (CVA) requiring rehabilitative therapy
- ◆ Patients requiring rehab including cardiac and pulmonary rehabilitation/therapy

Financial Information

Skilled Care is a Medicare Program offered at LRHC. Patients must have Medicare as their primary insurance with private insurances as secondary. Your physician and our hospital staff will help you determine if you qualify for Medicare coverage. If you meet the requirements, Medicare will pay 100 percent of approved charges for the first 20 days.
